Registration Guidelines for CSR Training Workshops

As part of the Program commitment, interns are required to complete 20-hour CSR Training Series prior to the 160-hour placement. The training workshops comprise of **10** hours of Compulsory Sessions and minimum **10** hours but maximum 15 hours of Elective Social Outreach Sessions.

1. Workshops are divided into 4 categories with respective themes (Aging Population, Gap between Rich and Poor, Environmental Protection & Social Enterprise). Students are required to attend **ALL** Compulsory Sessions and select **4** Elective Sessions from the list of workshops. Please be noted the **vaccination requirement** of the sessions required by different venues.

Remarks:

1. The registration links will **ONLY** be available on **Monday to Friday (10:00-17:00)**. The registration forms will be **closed** once the quotas of the workshops are reached.
2. For the elective sessions with vaccination requirement, **ONLY interns who fulfill the requirement** can register for these sessions. Zoom option will **NOT** be arranged for experiential workshops for better learning experience.
3. Confirmation email will be sent to you **within 2 weeks after the deadline**.
4. Pandemic precautionary measures will be implemented during the training, include temperature check, hand hygiene, etc. and all interns are required to have a mask on.
5. Interns are required to use the "**LeaveHomeSafe**" **mobile application** to scan the venue QR code before entering specific venues (except for exempted persons). Under the "**Vaccine Pass**" arrangement, please carry "Vaccine Pass" / an electronic version or paper copy of COVID-19 vaccination record / Exemption Certificate with you while entering the venues or during spot checks. The arrangement may be updated according to the latest government disease prevention measures.
6. Restricted by the training requirement, absent and late to trainings will subject to training hour deduction/ disqualification and will be informed on the event day. Please note that **absence or more than 15-minute lateness** of each training session is required to participate in **1-day voluntary service** in July-August 2022 to compensate the training hours.
7. Sick leave certificate / letter from university with valid explanation need to be provided and sent to cip@hkcss.org.hk in prior to your absence.
